

TO OUR FAMILY,

Five years ago, we began an exploration into urban farming in a food desert that has grown into a thriving community ministry serving adults & children across South Nashville.

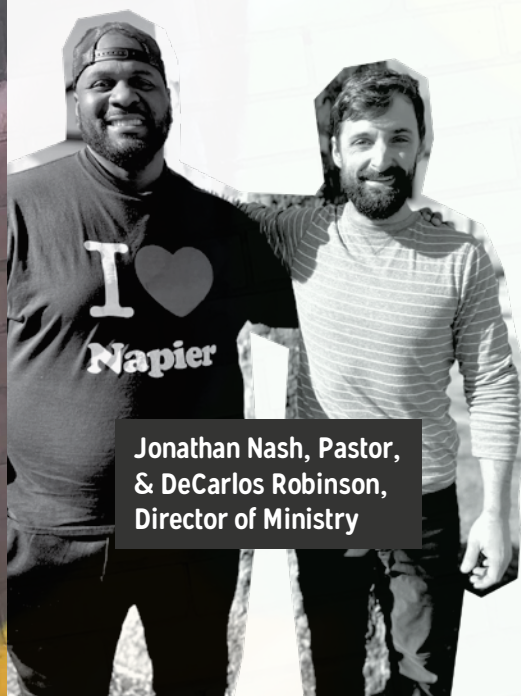
2021 was particularly challenging in a community of historic poverty, where many people who already live on razor-thin margins found themselves in impossible situations. In this seemingly hopeless place of sickness, school closures, and lost jobs, doors that might never have opened were flung wide. In the last year we have:

- Grown an intensive door-to-door ministry of prayer and material support for 60 families
- Built a youth ministry of over 30 students who meet weekly for spiritual formation and fun
- Started a weekly farmers market outside the local Dollar General where fresh and affordable produce is sold
- Delivered 900 stockings to families in the community with Santa and Rudolph on the back of a sleigh

Perhaps the most impactful development came at the beginning of the year when DeCarlos Robinson joined our team as Napier Director of Ministry. DeCarlos brings over a decade of local youth development and family engagement experience and is a vital partner in this work.

In the last year, we have seen strangers become neighbors and neighbors become family. As we look to 2022, we hope to see this family begin to worship together, break bread, and serve their community. We have a potential building that would include worship, adult, and youth ministry space for us and become central to our ministry in Napier. We hope and pray that our youth ministry and time meeting with adults in their homes and at community events would bring us the people God us calling to start a new church congregation in Napier.

Midtown Fellowship is one church family, made up of people from all over Nashville. By God's faithfulness working through your prayers, volunteerism, and generous and unsolicited financial support, we have added to our beloved Midtown church family people from God's great family who live in another part of our city. We deeply thank you and are excited that we get to share updates from the past year and our vision for 2022.
